"Liberatingly delicious"

Blond beer from culinary tandem Thierry Theys-Victor Derks

2 Michelin Star chef Thierry Theys and awardwinning sommelier Victor Derks bring their taste buds and their culinary expertise together in blond and hoppy beer that is "degustation" and tastes "liberatingly delicious".



The name of the beer *François Grand Cru* comes from the Latin meaning of the word François, which means "free man". Theys and Derks have therefore taken the liberty of turning a tried and tested old Antwerp beer recipe into a contemporary and gastronomic version.



The "liberating taste" is in reducing the great complexity of the formula to its simple essence. In a biologically responsible way, with a balanced balance on the palette and with respect for traditional brewing methods.

François Grand Cru is full-bodied, ripe and fresh. It has a hint of peach but the depth of the aroma is mainly in the various types of fresh hops with which it is prepared.

François Grand Cru contains nine percent alcohol, comes in bottles of thirty-three centilitres and has a top fermentation.
